

FLYING DUTCHMAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2019

July 19 – 21, 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Organizing Authority

1.1 The organizing authority is the Flying Dutchman Class of North America.

2. Venue

2.1 The regatta venue is Willow Bank Yacht Club (WBYC), Cazenovia, New York.

2.2 Racing will take place on Cazenovia Lake.

3. Rules

3.1 The current Racing Rules of Sailing (except as changed by this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions) will govern the regatta.

4. Eligibility

4.1 The regatta is restricted to Flying Dutchman class boats. Both crewmembers must be current members of the IFDCAUS.

5. Registration

5.1 Competitors are urged to register online the Willow Bank Yacht Club (WBYC) website at willowbankyc.com. Alternatively you can register onsite or can mail in the completed entry form below, accompanied with a check.

5.2 Registration will be on Thursday, July 18th at Willow Bank Yacht Club from 1600 hrs to 1800 hrs. Registration will also be at WBYC Friday, July 19th from 0800 to 0900 hrs.

5.3 Completed entry forms and fees must be received no later than 0900 hrs Friday, July 19.

6. Entry Fee

6.1 Entry fee includes three days of racing, trophies, breakfasts and lunch on Friday, and Saturday and Sunday as well as a fleet-dinner on Saturday night. There is also an optional Fish Fry offering burgers etc., at the club on Friday evening that is available at your expense. Two tee shirts per boat will provided with entry fee. Additional tee shirts will be \$15 extra each.

6.2 Entry fee will be \$160 per boat (\$150 per boat for US Sailing members). Checks should be made out to WBYC.

7. Schedule of Events

7.2 No warning will be given after 1200 hrs, Sunday.

7.3 On Friday, Saturday and Sunday FDs will be the only fleet on the course.

8. Event Format

- 8.1 The course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 8.2 Boats are encouraged to record GPS tracks for later download to www.strava.com as long as the GPS tracks are not used to aide competitors while racing.

9. Sailing Instructions

- 9.1 Sailing instructions will be available on WBYC website and at registration.

10. Advertising

- 10.1 This event will be governed by the RRS, Appendix 1, Regulation 20.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 The low-point-scoring system of RRS, Appendix A will be used with modifications as specified in 11.2, 11.3, and 11.4.
- 11.2 A minimum of 3 races is required to constitute a series.
- 11.3 If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's worst race will be dropped before calculating the overall results. If nine or more races are completed, a boat's two worst races will be dropped before calculating overall results.
- 11.4 If fewer than 5 races are completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

12. Prizes

- 12.1 Prizes will be awarded to the drivers and crews placing first, second, and third, as well as the National Trophy for first place boat, a trophy for highest placing boat older than 1980, and a trophy for highest placing crew with combined ages no greater than 50 years.

- 13.1 All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk. The organizing authority accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience incurred, howsoever caused.
