In consideration of Willow Bank Yacht Club's providing sailing instructions to my child, I hereby release, acquit, and discharge the Willow Bank Yacht Club, its successors and assigns, its employees, agents, members, volunteers, officers and directors from all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, damages, injuries and cost of any nature or kind, whether property, personal injury or bodily injury, or any other type of injury or damage that may arise from my child's participation in the sailing program and his or her use of the facilities of the Club and its equipment. This release is on my behalf as the parent or legal guardian and on behalf of my child and any person claiming through my child.

I understand the risks inherent in the sport of sailing, in water sports in general and in any activity involving children. I understand that I am responsible for providing my child with a U.S. Coast Guard approved Type III personal flotation device for use at all times while participating in sailing activities. I attest that my participating child has had swimming instructions, is capable of treading water for five minutes and swimming 25 meters with good form and easy breathing (any stroke), and can demonstrate the capacity to alternately float and tread water for an unlimited period of time. I understand that these skills may help reduce the risks, but cannot eliminate them.

I also attest that my participating child is free and unencumbered by any physical or mental impairment and is free of any contagious or infectious disease that might interfere with his or her health or safety during this program.

I give authorization to the Willow Bank Yacht Club to provide or seek treatment for my child in the event of any accident or injury if I cannot be reached.

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2017 JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAMS Descriptions

Learn to Sail (8-14)

Focused on beginner sailors (no experience required, but must be able to swim*), scheduled in the morning with gentler winds.

Sailors will learn

- Intro to boats (parts, storage, rigging, knots)
- Wind clock and points of sail
- Basic boat control
- Capsize righting

Successful completion of this course results in the ability to sail a small sailboat (alone) with growing confidence in a variety of sailing conditions. A great first sailing experience!

*As determined by the WBYC head lifeguard.

Youth Sailing (8-18)

Focused on growing a wide range of sailing skills in a non-competitive environment. Scheduled in the afternoon for strong and more varied wind conditions. Opportunity to sail a wider variety of boats in our club fleet (Lightning, Flying Scott, Sunfish) in addition to the standard youth sailing boats (420 and Opti).

Sailors will:

- Gain confidence as a solo sailor, and/or improved captain/crew sailing skills
- Be able to land at sailing dock and launch unassisted
- Learn to handle a boat in heavy wind conditions
- Experience advanced navigation techniques and boat handling in traffic
- Rig and sail different boat classes

This course will benefit sailors who wish to improve their overall sailing ability, and provides the training and opportunity to sail in a non-competitive, social atmosphere. Repeat attendance is welcome, with the opportunity to build upon previous classes/experience.

Jr. Fleet

Race-focused sailing program for experienced sailors tailored to bring their sailing skills to the next level in competitiveness. Scheduled in the afternoon for strong and more varied wind conditions, this program will focus on skills development for competition, but maintain a fun atmosphere. Sailors will specialize in top-to-bottom knowledge of our race boats (Opti, 420, and Lasers), and compete in a summer long season of Interclub regattas. Increased practice time with three days per week of instruction and one regatta per week.

Further competitive sailing opportunities are also available to Jr. Fleet members, including:

- Participation in Sunday point races with the other fleets, either in Laser/Opti/420's or in other classes (e.g. Lightnings, Sunfish)
- Opportunities to assist the race committee on Sundays - a great way to learn race management, signal flags, sound signals and scoring.

Participation in the Jr. Fleet program requires instructor approval. Jr Fleet is open to WBYC members only, (junior membership options are available).
